Permanent Full Time

Full day shifts in other rooms may be offered as needed.

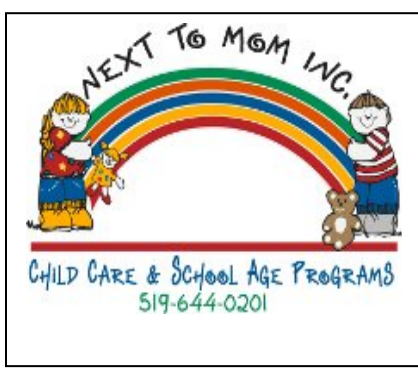
Candidates should be able to do the following:
